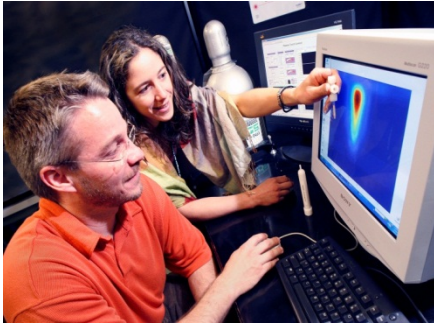




## Awards for Outstanding Teaching



Undergraduate and graduate students registered in the Faculty of Engineering are invited to nominate professors for three awards in recognition of outstanding teaching performance:

- The ***Class of '44 Award***, which is based on an endowment created to promote high-quality and excellence in teaching in undergraduate degree programs;
- The ***Samuel & Ida Fromson Award***, which is based on an endowment created to recognize outstanding teaching performance by an Engineering professor; and
- The ***Class of 1890 Award***, to recognize exceptional contributions in teaching made by Course Lecturers and/or non-Engineering McGill professors who teach engineering students.

The teaching awards, which include recognition at the Spring Convocation in 2015, a monetary award, and a plaque, are given to recognize a professor's overall effectiveness in the preparation for, and carrying out of teaching activities and duties.
