The second Possible Dimensions contest is seeking proposals by emerging and mid-career artists. Enter for the opportunity to win technical design and creative support from top professionals to realize your dream project, and for the opportunity to be part of the Possible Dimensions summer 2015 curated exhibition in Montreal, Canada.

Prizes:

1st place: \$1750 in Faux-Cadres Canal products and/or services. August exhibition and vernissage hosted by C.O.A. Gallery, Montreal, and curated by Studio Beluga, transportation for artwork provided by Fero Transport *

2nd place: \$1250 in Faux-Cadres Canal products and/or services. August exhibition and vernissage hosted by C.O.A. Gallery, Montreal, and curated by Studio Beluga, transportation for artwork provided by Fero Transport*

** Transportation may be available pending location and size of artwork.*

Submissions should include:

- A 250-400 word description of the proposed "dream project" to be executed by the applicant upon winning the contest. In addition to the creative vision, this statement should communicate the applicant's needs and requirements, and what technical expertise they seek.
- A rough visual sketch/rendering of proposed work (max. 8 ½" x 11")
- 5-10 images and descriptions of the applicant's previous work
- CV and short artist biography.
- Application fee of \$20 payable by paypal or an interact money transfer to alinamaizel@gmail.com
