This map of the Expo grounds from a guidebook shows the changing nature of movement through Ile-Ste-Helene. Here, not only does the car have precedence, but a monorail circulates the perimeter of the island. The city-like grid of the pavilion fairgrounds contrasts the ambling paths laid out by Frederick Todd in the forest. Unlike Todd's plans, the perimeters are dedicated to movement - not leisure.
