

PROBLEMS / OPPORTUNITIES

Walkley Parking / Ambulance Entrance

Establishing a hierarchy of users is a key factor when organizing how a space should be used. At this hospital an area under some pressure to successfully fulfil multiple roles is the parking lot which runs parallel with the path to the side entrance (which is also the busiest entrance). The lack of parking at the facility is apparent, and the special configuration of this space does not do it any favours.

There is not a lot of opportunity for reconfiguration of the parking arrangement although the access path to the side entrance is very wide, there is a minimum required width for ambulances accessing the site. In its contemporary context there is no need for an emergency entrance, however some patients are still transferred to this hospital in ambulances, and more commonly by taxis.
