Walkley Entrance

The transformation of the Catherine Booth Hospital has not been seamless, and one clumsy transition was the front-to-back designation of the Walkley entrance.

This entrance was the historic front of the original hospital, but for reasons of access and internal programs became the back over the course of development. Entrances are key nodal points along the circulation paths through buildings, and should function as such.

The Walkley entrance is no longer used as a point of public access to the hospital but there have been no physical alterations/interventions to address the change of status. Spaces adjacent to this entrance have been treated differently due to its lack of use (cars park very close to the steps leading up to the entrance).
