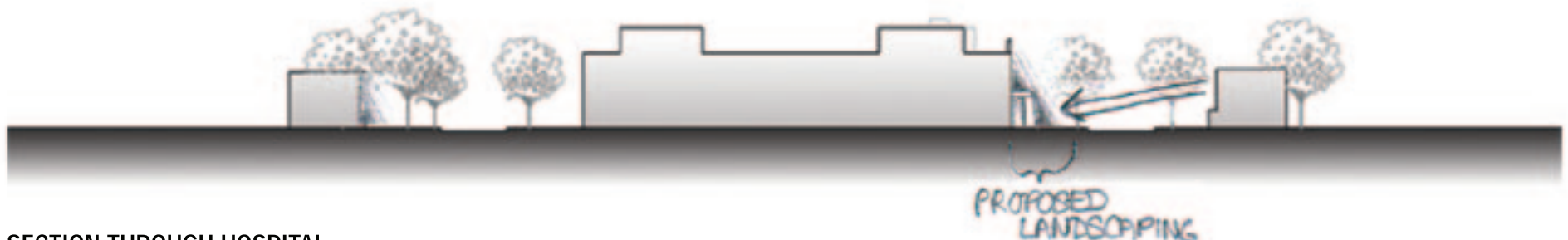


Dating from 1955, the Walkley entrance has some historic value, the extent of which we cannot conclusively say. Perhaps the issue of signage for this entrance could be a simple solution that could clear up a potential source of confusion.

Another, more radical solution, would be to replace the doorway with a large window that would continue to allow natural light to enter the circulation space within, but would eliminate the confusion of having a door with no use.

Landscaping would also be a possible solution where the paved surface could be transformed into a lawn with plants and benches. This would help to revitalize the space, which is currently completely vacant of activity.

There is definitely the opportunity to create a new relationship with the neighbourhood where its residents would be encouraged to use the spaces on Walkley Avenue.
