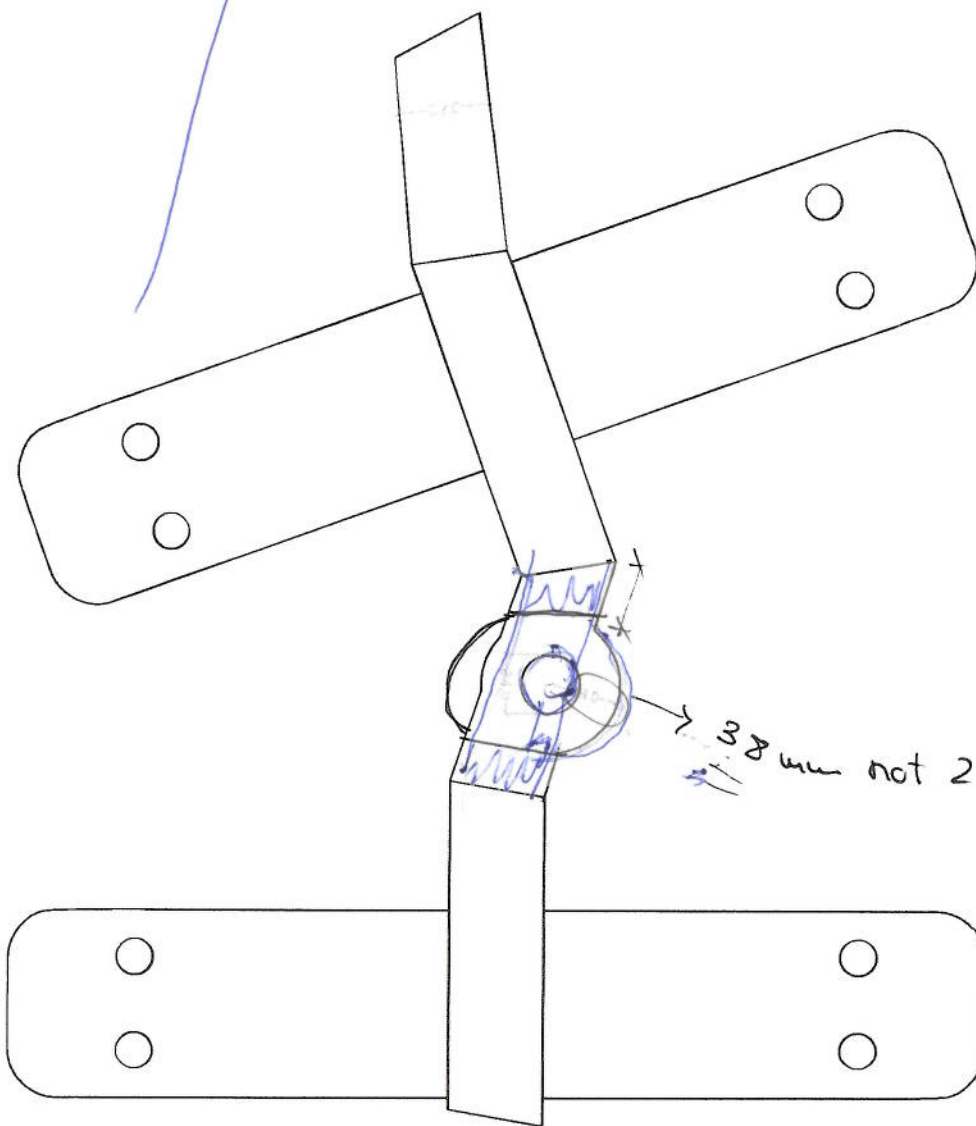


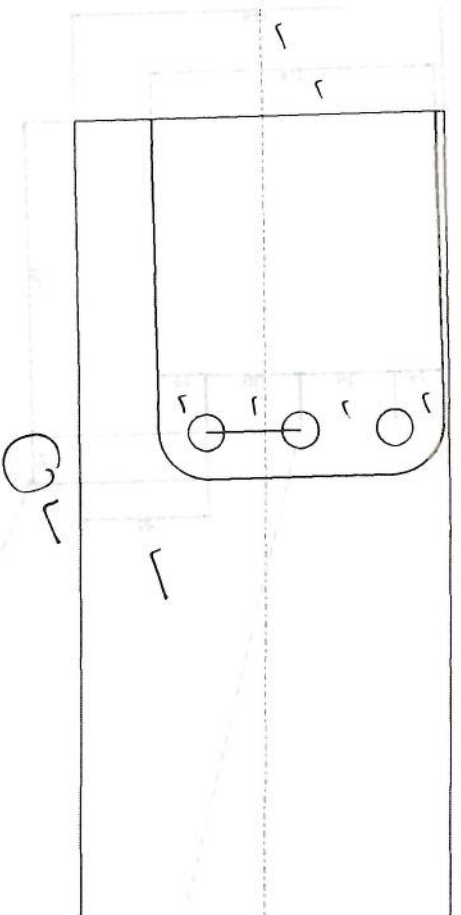

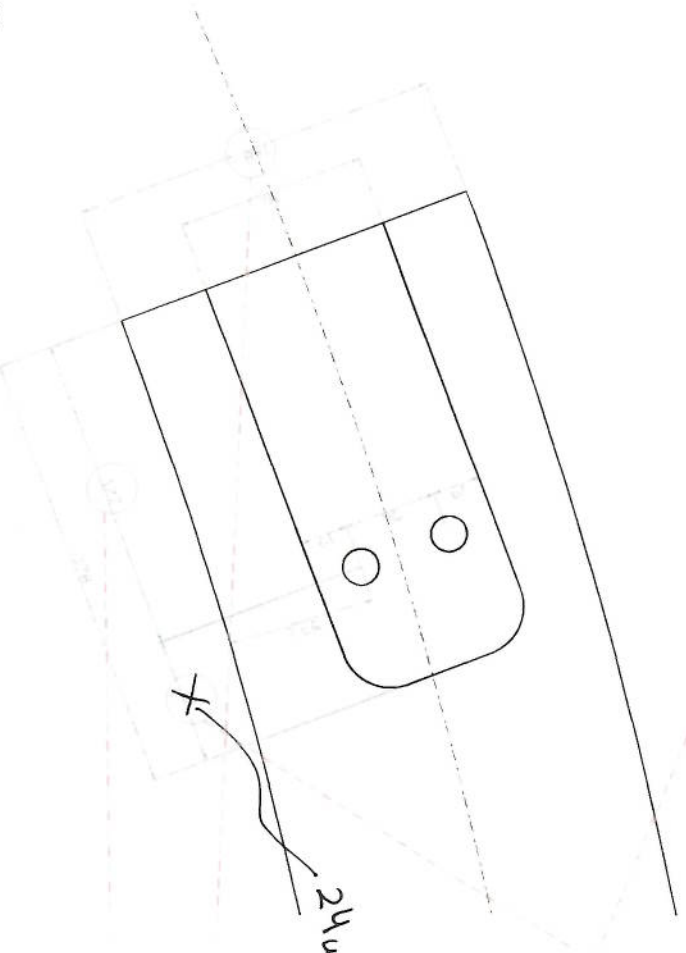


On page 1 in the document you sent us, there is a dimension of 88mm (located in the bottom center of the page). To what does it refer? → ??

Bolt diameters = 14.7mm (12.7mm bolt size + 2mm)
 Hole diameter = 14.9mm
 Bolt " = 12.7mm

Are these dimensions correct? 19mm & 24mm



The ribs are currently scripted at a constant width of 148mm. Preferably, we would like it to remain as such instead of varying the width. Is this possible or would dead weight be an issue?

This dimension seems quite large, is there any way to reduce it?
 No, it is too due with failing of the plywood due to shear in the bolts in reality there is no need for the plate to be as long but the bolts need to be 7x dia from the center of bolt.
